1. Based on the current concept site plan, please select your TOP 3 features that you would like to be added to the Kānehili Community Association Park. (80 responses)

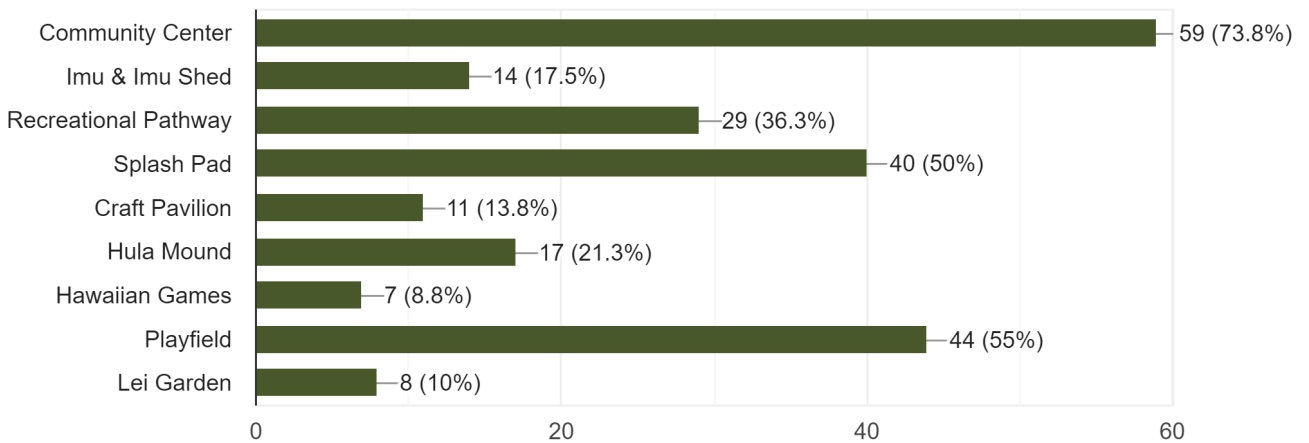


Figure 1, May 2021
