








































Hotel Street

Hotel Street is one of the central streets in Chinatown. It is the only street that is reserved for busses and shares entrances with the major destination hubs along the heart of Chinatown.






Business Functions



Kekaulike Street

Introduction





Kekaulike Street spans two blocks running one way from Mauka to Makai. The Mauka block of the street is a pedestrian mall housing Kekaulike market. In the years to come, the whole street will become a pedestrian mall since the Chinatown rail station will be built at the intersection of Nimitz Highway and Kekaulike.


Anchors KEKAULIKE MIMITZHWY

KEKAULIKE LOOKING TOWARDS EWA: Parking at end of Kekaulike is a private lot. Closest municipal parking is one block over near River Street.



Introduction





Day vs. Night




Pauahi Street

Pauahi is a one way street, at rush hour traffic builds up and there is often a traffic cop.




There is no Bike lane, so the street is used, and the bike racks are often crowded.




Between River and Maunakea there is a great deal of homeless around the River of Life center.

The River of Life has become an anchor for the homeless.




Mark's Garage is a popular place to park and is home to an art gallery.






Smith Street

LOWER SHOP FLOORS: Multiple advertisements for upper floor rent are seen. People living in area would bring more people to stores/restaurants in area.




