
Most people come to Chinatown to work, eat, and shop.

It is busiest on Mondays, during 9:00am through 1:00pm.









Based on the 33 surveys conducted yesterday, there were more people who visited Chinatown on a weekly/ monthly basis, and most people visited for more than 2 hours.
