Stakeholder Engagement & Stakeholder Mapping

Stakeholders are the people who live, work, play and/or have a connection to a particular place/community. In the coming week, we will make a deliberate effort to interact with Chinatown Stakeholders and encourage them to participate in our forthcoming Workshop on Saturday, 7/11.

Starting at tomorrow's Chinatown Summit, meet as many Chinatown Stakeholders as possible. Strike up a brief conversation by introducing yourself and asking a few questions. Below are some sample questions:

- Why are you here?
- What do you do in/for Chinatown?
- Where do you live/work/play/eat/shop?

Ultimately, we will be gathering/recording the Stakeholders' stories and hopes for Chinatown.

Below is a list of more detailed requirements and deliverables:

1. Working in teams of 2-3 collect names and email contact of those who are willing to share it. Take a pic of people if they allow it.
2. Hand out the 7/11 Workshop announcement card and invite people to it.
3. Continue this process on the streets of Chinatown next week.
4. Meet collectively as a group and develop a Chinatown Stakeholder Map – start by listing the stakeholder and matching them with activities/locations.
5. Organize your raw images/data into a coherent visual presentation that includes the following:
 - Make a 10 minute presentation (on screen) of your Documentation on Friday at 1:30pm
 - Archive your raw data and presentation **on the Chinatown Server File**
 - Ideally, we will merge this info with either Kawa Mamua and/or Mustard Square.
6. Schedule:
 - Chinatown Summit, Saturday, 6/27, 8:30AM
 - Review Engagement results and Stakeholder diagram on Thursday, 7/2, 4pm at SHADE.

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
